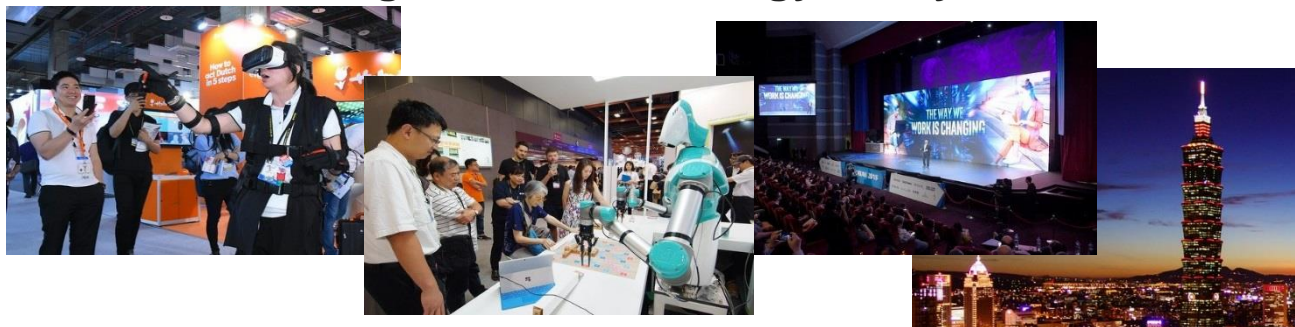


## Visit Computex Taipei 2019 Building Global Technology Ecosystems

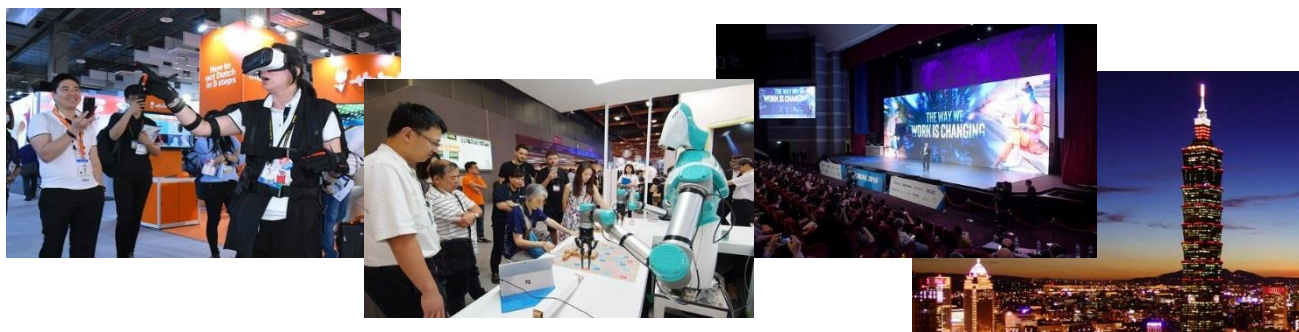
