While we are justifiably proud of the selfless contributions of our pioneer generation, we will continue to strive for a wonderful future. At times of peace, it is especially important to treasure inter-ethnic trust, ensure the stability of the tripartite relationship among workers, employers and the government, and stay vigilant at all times to address tumultuous changes in the external environment.

Throughout the years of nation-building, Chinese entrepreneurs have persevered with the spirit of integrity, loyalty and giving back to society, and made significant contributions to our nation's development. Integrity is the most cherished virtue in

The conference theme of "Embracing Realities, Creating Opportunities" will explore how enterprises could transform and seize new opportunities in the new digital economy, to address the host of changes brought about by disruptive technologies. These conference topics are of the greatest concern to local enterprises. We have received a record-breaking registration of more than 6,000 to-date. united in working hard, the future will be bright and full of hope!
