15.	Country of Origin of Goods Country in which goods were produced / manufactured and given their final form
16.	Code for Country of Origin of Goods State the 2-alpha Country Code Note: The code is obtainable from the website – http://www.tradenet.gov.sg
17.	Port of Loading The first port at which goods were loaded on Vessel / Aircraft / Vehicle for export to Singapore
18.	Code for Port of Loading State the 5-alpha Port Code (LOCODE) Note: The code is obtainable from the website – http://www.tradenet.gov.sg

19. Type of Trade

The Type of Trade, namely *Direct* or *Re-export*

Note:

Direct - Goods are for local consumption or for use in manufacturing and payment is made in Singapore

Re-export - Goods imported are for sale to a foreign country, irrespective of whether or not there is re-packing, splitting into bundles, sorting, grading or marking

20. Transport Mode

The Transport Mode, namely Sea, Road or Air

21. Cargo Packing Type

The type of Cargo Packing, namely *Bulk*, *Conventional*, *Container* or *Airborne*

22. | Total Outer Packing

The total number of Outer Package(s) and Unit of Measurement

23. Gross Weight

The Gross Weight of the goods (Including the packaging materials)

Note:

For Sea Consignment – Indicate in Tonnes (TNE)

For Air Consignment – Indicate in Kilograms (KGM)

For Road Consignment – Indicate in Kilograms (KGM) or Tonnes (TNE)

24. Container Identifier

Comprises of **Container Number**, **Container Type**, **Container Size** and **Shipper's Seal Number** (Applies only to Containerised Consignment)

Note:

Container Number – State the Container Number

Container Type – State either Full Container Load (FCL) or Less than Full Container Load (LCL)

Container Size – State either 20 Footer or 40 Footer type

Shipper's Seal Number – State the Shipper's Seal Number

25. Description of Goods

A brief description of the goods based on the particulars in the supplier's invoice. The number of packages should also be stated correctly for each item. For imports, brand name for each item must be declared; otherwise state "unbranded" for item with no brand name

26. Product Code

State the assigned Product Code (Applies only to controlled items)

27. Establishment Code

State the Establishment Code – (Applies only to certain controlled items)

28. Commodity Codes (HS codes)

Commodity Codes are the 8-digit Harmonised System (HS) Codes which are the international nomenclature for the classification of goods. Goods that are classified under different HS Codes must be declared separately at item level

Note:

The HS Codes are obtainable from the Singapore Trade Classification, Customs and Excise Duties, 2003 publication

29. CIF/LSP Value

The CIF/LSP value in Singapore dollars (S\$) for each item

Note:

CIF / LSP - The cost/sale price of the goods including insurance and freight or the last selling price in Singapore dollars (S\$)

30. Quantity

Quantity must be stated as in accordance to the Singapore Trade Classification, Customs and Excise Duties, 2003 publication

Note:

Quantity by weight refers to nett weight of the goods (ie. without packaging)

31. Quantity Unit Code

State the Unit of Quantity Code, as in accordance to the Singapore Trade Classification, Customs and Excise Duties, 2003 publication

32. GST Rate

All goods imported into Singapore are subject to 4% Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Note:

With effective from 1 Jan 2004, the GST rate will be increased from 4% to 5%

33. **GST Amount**

The GST amount in Singapore dollars (S\$) for each item (Applies only to import of non-dutiable goods subject to GST payment)

Note:

Calculation of GST Amount -- CIF/LSP x GST Rate
