SPEECH BY SCCCI PRESIDENT THOMAS CHUA AT THE SCCCI LUNAR NEW YEAR GATHERING MONDAY, FEBRUARY 8 2015 SCCCI Auditorium

2016 will be a special year for the SCCCI, as it will mark our 110th anniversary. A whole host of celebratory events will be organised throughout the year, under the theme of "A New Era, A New Chapter". I am delighted that Minister Iswaran has joined us for our Lunar New Year gathering, and will officiate the launch of the 110th Anniversary logo later.

A series of interesting activities will be organised to celebrate our 110th year. These include a forum by our Career Women's Group, a charity golf tournament, a China Forum, a mega conference and expo to drive growth and technology adoption. The Singapore Chinese Chamber Institute of Business will also introduce an e-learning



portal. The highlight of our celebrations will be in September, when our Young Entrepreneurs Network will be organising a cruise involving counterparts from the region; a Trade Association Congress will also be held. As a finale, the Gala Dinner for the 110th Anniversary will be on the 23rd of September. We invite you to participate in all these activities.

2016 marks the 110th anniversary of the SCCCI, and we have adopted the theme of "A New Era, A New Chapter" to kick off a whole host of celebratory events. I would like to thank Minister S Iswaran for attending our Lunar New Year gathering today, and for personally officiating the launch of the 110th anniversary logo. It would set the stage for many interesting activities, among which are a forum by our Career Women's Group, a charity golf tournament, a forum on Singapore-China collaborations, as well as a mega conference and expo to spur the growth of enterprises and technology adoption. The Singapore Chinese Chamber Institute of Business will also introduce an e-learning portal.

The 110th anniversary will culminate with three key events to be held on September 21-23. A trio of separate events will be organised consecutively over these three days, including the Trade Association Congress focused on the theme of industry upgrading,
