First Stage Results to SCCCI's 61st Council Elections

The Singapore Chinese Chamber of Commerce & Industry (SCCCI) held the first stage of elections for its 61st Council on 11 October 2021 (Monday). The results are attached for your reference.

At this first stage, existing Council Members elected 15 persons from among the current Corporate and Individual Council Members and 3 persons from among the current Trade Association Council Members to enter the 61st Council.

The SCCCI elections are carried out in three stages. At the second stage, the Trade Association Members shall elect from among themselves 14 representatives as Council Members. The results of the second stage will be released on 28 October 2021 (Thursday).

At the third stage, the Corporate or Individual members shall elect from among themselves 23 representatives as Council Members.

The Council consists of 56 members: 38 individuals representing Corporate or Individual members, 17 individuals representing Trade Association members, and the Immediate Past President.
