Second Stage Results to SCCCI's 62nd Council Elections

The Singapore Chinese Chamber of Commerce & Industry (SCCCI) held the second stage of elections for its 62nd Council on 30 October 2024 (Wednesday). At this stage, SCCCI's Trade Association members elected 14 representatives from among themselves as Council Members. The results are attached for your reference.

The SCCCI elections are carried out in three stages. At the first stage, existing Council Members elected 15 persons from among the current Corporate and Individual Council Members and 3 persons from among the current Trade Association Council Members for the 62nd Council. The results of the first stage were released on 14 October 2024. At the third stage, the Corporate or Individual Members shall elect 23 representatives from among themselves as Council Members.

The Council consists of 56 members: 38 individuals representing Corporate or Individual members, 17 individuals representing Trade Association members, and the Immediate Past President.
