## SCCCI EXPRESSES ITS GRATITUDE TO MIGRANT WORKERS THROUGH DOUBLING ITS SPONSORSHIP OF MANDARIN ORANGES

To spread festive cheer and show appreciation towards the migrant workers in our community, SCCCI responded to Ministry of Manpower's (MOM) call to donate over 156,000 mandarin oranges to the migrant workers residing in 19 dormitories. This is almost double the number that SCCCI had contributed at the Lunar New Year last year.

Giving mandarin oranges is a tradition that symbolizes auspicious and good fortune during the Chinese New Year. A vivid demonstration of the SCCCI Chinese Entrepreneurial Spirit of giving back to the society, SCCCI is taking the opportunity to express gratitude to our migrant workers for their contribution to Singapore. At the Chinese New Year Carnival held at the Westlite Kranji Way Dormitory, these mandarin oranges were distributed to the migrant workers by Minister for Manpower Dr Tan See Leng and Senior Minister of State for Manpower Dr Koh Poh Koon, accompanied by SCCCI President Mr Roland Ng and incoming SCCCI President-elect Mr Kho Choon Keng.

Our migrant workers complement very well the local workforce to allow businesses to thrive and spur economic development.
