## New Trends and Opportunities in Hainan's Offshore Duty-Free Market, Healthcare & Cultural Tourism Industries

The Overseas Market Workshop is organised by Singapore Chinese Chamber of Commerce & Industry (SCCCI) and supported by Enterprise Singapore (EnterpriseSG)

#### Conducted in Mandarin

Since the Chinese central government proposed the complete closure and operation of Hainan Island, the province has been gradually preparing for this initiative, which is planned to start at the end of 2025. After the closure, Hainan will implement a "first-line opening, second-line control, and free movement within the island" system for the import and export management of goods. This will promote economic exchanges between Hainan and the world, optimise the industrial structure, and drive economic development. The closure will also facilitate the entry and exit of residents and tourists, as well as economic and trade activities, thereby improving the quality of life and the tourism experience. The health and wellness tourism industry will become a pillar of Hainan's economy.

#### Why should I participate?

- Understand the preferential policies of Hainan Free Trade Port and key industry investment opportunities
- Learn about the offshore duty-free shopping policy in Hainan and the current state and development potential of the market

It is the world's largest single-duty-free shop, operated by China Duty Free Group. The duty-free commercial center has a total construction area of 289,000 square meters, with a two-story underground reinforced concrete structure covering approximately 140,000 square meters, and a four-story above-ground all-steel structure covering approximately 150,000 square meters. <b>Wednesday 31 Jul 2024</b>	<p><b>Session 11: Yangpu Economic Development Zone</b> Company Visit + Presentation + Seminar</p> <p>The Yangpu Economic Development Zone, located on the northwest coast of Hainan Province, was approved by the State Council in 1992 as China's first national-level development zone with preferential policies akin to a bonded zone. It's a hub for industrialization, circular economy, and green initiatives, boasting excellent port conditions with over 300 operational days annually. Its strategic location as China's southernmost national-level development zone and bonded port area, along with proximity to key international ports, makes it an ideal entry point for oil and gas resources from the Middle East and Africa. Managed by the Yangpu Economic Development Zone Working Committee and the Management Committee, it oversees development and investment attraction in the Dongfang Lingang Industrial Park and Lingao Jingang Port Development Zone, ensuring top-notch environmental quality.</p> <p><b><u>Learning Points:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Visit and explore the exhibition gallery of the Yangpu Economic Development Zone</li><li>• Gain insights into the development history and future planning of Yangpu Port</li><li>• Discuss with the Management Committee of the Yangpu Economic Development Zone regarding spatial layout, strategic positioning, industrial development, management and operation mechanisms, talent attraction, environmental assessment, integrated development of port-industry-city, foreign investment policies, etc</li></ul>

<b>Thursday 1 Aug 2024</b>	<p><b>Session 13: Yangpu International Healthy Food Port</b> Company Visit + Presentation + Seminar</p> <p>In recent years, Yangpu has focused on developing its international health food port, targeting four key sub-industries: functional foods, specialty health foods, premium meats, and healthy oils and fats. Plans include establishing a "demonstration zone" covering nearly 3,000 acres in the Yangpu Free Trade Port Area and surrounding development zones, with a total investment of 10.7 billion yuan. Construction is underway for nine projects, including those by China Grain Reserves Corporation, Longda Foods, and Dongyi Foods, while seven projects are already in production, expected to generate over 5 billion yuan in output value. This development is creating a health food industry cluster with a total output value exceeding 10 billion yuan, boosting the competitiveness of the industrial system.</p> <p><u>Learning Points:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Understand the favorable conditions for establishing factories in the Yangpu Free Trade Port Area, including policies for processing and value-added tax exemption, as well as the well-developed shipping industry at Yangpu Port</li><li>• Understand how the health food industry can benefit from the policy advantages of the Hainan Free Trade Port and the incentive mechanisms that support enterprise innovation and development</li></ul> <p><b>Session 14: Hainan Ausca International Oil and Grains Company (AUSCA)</b> Company Visit + Presentation + Seminar</p> <p>AUSCA is situated in the Yangpu Economic Development Zone, within the Free Trade Port Area. With a total investment of 3.5 billion yuan and spanning an area of 208 acres, the factory is designed in accordance with the standards of "Made in China 2025". It has incorporated internationally advanced grain and oil processing series supporting equipment to ensure that product quality meets international standards. It plays a crucial role in supporting the cultural development of the Hainan Free Trade Port and contributes to the province's cultural strength. Dongpo culture's charm resonates both nationally and internationally. Ronald Egan, Director of the Chinese Studies Department at Stanford University, regards Su Dongpo's writings and thoughts during his time in Hainan as worthy of study. Su Dongpo lectured at the Dongpo Academy in Danzhou, leaving behind the essence of his life's thoughts in Hainan.</p> <p><u>Learning Points:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Understand how Hainan promotes the complementary advantages of Dongpo culture with tourism, cultural creativity, and educational tourism industries</li><li>• Strengthen potential opportunities for deepening cultural and tourism exchanges and cooperation with relevant parties in Hainan</li></ul> <p><b>Session 16: Hainan Jiahe Shared Farm</b> Company Visit + Presentation + Seminar</p> <p>Rural sharing is an innovative development model aimed at revitalising rural areas by leveraging village communities, farmers, and internet technology. In Hainan Province, the concept of "shared farms" was pioneered, with Jiahe Shared Farm being a prime example. Located in Youwen Village, Nanfeng Town, Danzhou City, it focuses on tropical fruits, offering market-oriented experiences such as dining, leisure, recreation, and education. Originally a 5,000-acre brickyard and wasteland purchased by Mr and Mrs Zhou Jinzhi from Zhejiang in 2013, it has since transformed into a thriving rural tourism destination integrating agriculture, processing, and sightseeing industries. In 2022, it earned the prestigious title of Golden Coconut Award for Shared Farm.</p> <p><u>Learning Points:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Learn the theme of tropical fruit IP in Hainan, and create the "first tropical agricultural Disneyland in China" as a shared rural project</li><li>• Understand the development model and successful experiences of Jiahe</li></ul>
